



RULES AND REGULATIONS OF VISITING THE UNDERGROUND TOURIST PASSAGE UNDER THE TENEMENT BUILDINGS RYNEK 4, 5, 6 IN JAROSŁAW

1. The Underground Tourist Passage is monitored.
2. The Underground Tourist Passage is not adapted for persons with reduced mobility.
3. . The average visiting time of The Underground Tourist Passage is 50 minutes.
4. In order to visit The Underground Tourist Passage one should purchase the admission ticket.
5. Tours start in the Touristic and Cultural Information Point, The Centre for Culture and Promotion – Rynek 5.
- 6. The Underground Tourist Passage can be visited, individually or in organized groups, only under the supervision of a designated employee of The Centre for Culture and Promotion in Jarosław or with a designated PTTK-guide (additional charge).**
- 7. For safety reasons group tours are conducted in groups of a maximum of 15 people.** In justified cases the number of visitors may be increased.
8. Children up to 10 years of age are allowed to visit The Underground Tourist Passage only under the supervision of their adult caretaker, who is fully responsible for them.
9. Admission for children up to 4 years of age is free of charge. Does not apply to organized groups.
10. It is not advisable to visit The Underground Tourist Passage by: children under 5 years of age, people suffering from epilepsy or claustrophobia, people suffering from allergies.
11. The leader of an organized group is not obliged to have an admission ticket.
12. The admission to The Underground Tourist Passage is refused to people under the influence of alcohol or other substances having a similar effect.
13. During the tour it is forbidden to: smoke tobacco, litter the route, bring food, alter the structure of the walls, remove any objects on the route, touch the exhibits, make noise.
14. No animals are allowed in The Underground Tourist Passage.
15. During the tour of The Underground Tourist Passage one should be careful and follow the instructions of The Underground Tourist Passage staff and the rules of the Regulation.
16. The Centre for Culture and Promotion reserves the right to change the date of visiting and to a temporary exclusion of the whole route or its part.
- 17. Complaints and requests regarding The Underground Tourist Passage in Jarosław should be addressed to the Director of The Centre for Culture and Promotion in Jarosław, who manages the Passage.**
